

MEET THE DESIGNERS!

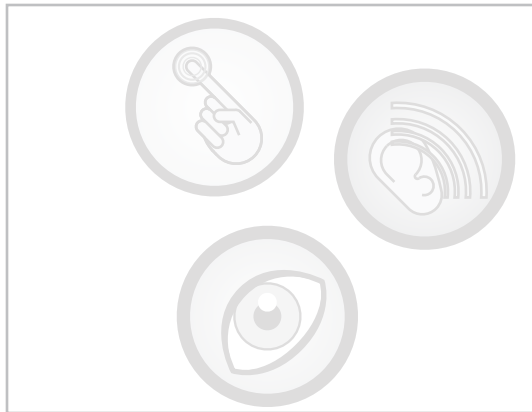
